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INTRODUCTION

I said no, and he said “It closed down”, what? That's a million dollar company they don't just close down like that, but that's what happen, no warning or nothing just everybody sent to unemployment, now I felt sorry for those people and their families because of the lost of their jobs, but at the same time I thought about (The Book of Jonah). I never tried to leave my church since then (even though it

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actually wasn't technically my job yet)I said to myself, I think I'll just wait till He calls me higher like he told me in the first place☺!

So after that so real event with God in my walk on **“The Journey”** I put my mind in gear and was totally ready to receive the gifts that were about to come to me due to my obedience, because I felt in my spirit I was on the doorstep to something great or at least on the doorstep of doing something I never done before and true to the God that I serve as I was reporting every day to my church my pastor came to me and said that they were going to give me a job (**Gift #1**). One of the funniest time I had going around ministering was when I went to this one facility and the lady was showing me around and she was saying to me 'Mr. Williams over

Anyway, I was and still am a grateful man for God doing what He has done and continue to do in my life. But as I was on "**The Journey**" with God out of nowhere It felt like I was hit in the stomach from a Mike Tyson in his prime punch (Now I don't actually know what that really feels like but just writing it and thinking about it hurts, so I'm sure feeling that in the natural would hurt even more, if not kill me).

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I've learned that anytime you get to a place where you seem lost you can always go back to what God said to you when He first called you, so going back to what He said to me, I remembered in the beginning He told me not be the things that I had become, but He also told me He wouldn't let me go, so I got myself in a situation where I had to work it out with God and therefore I had to go straight to God, so the first thing I did was **repented** and through that whole ordeal of allowing Jesus to cleanse me and allowing His Grace to work from the inside out **'Again'**, it's awesome because even though He knew my weakness He never used it against me instead He delivered me because He is my deliver, I held on to two Scripture (**Psalms 46:1, 119:112**) they say: **God is our refuge and strength, A very present help in trouble, It is time for You to act, O LORD.**

As I'm going through this situation God had others in mind, because God always gets the Glory out of every situation, so He told me to write another book and title it **"The Journey is too great for you" (Gift#5)**. So this book you have in your hands was birth through my struggles and only God has the power to birth something good out of something bad and only God has the power to turn our mess into a message of **Grace and Redemption**.

This book will be for all those who have been on a journey or those who are currently on one now, you may have been or currently are in bondage to that **"Spiritual Crack Cocaine"**, you may be a parent that just lose a child, or a pastor who stumbled due to the lust of the eyes, or a sibling who have been trying to help another sibling for years, or someone who just been called to

pastor a church, or a spouse who has just gotten a divorce, or you may be someone who have been battling sickness after sickness in your body, or maybe you're someone who wants to be used by God but you're trying to hold on to parts of your old lifestyle at the same time, or maybe you're a person who just backslid, or a ministry leader that loss the heart to serve God, or a person who have put too much on themselves, you may have disobedient children, you may have parents that are great pastors and ministers but at home when you need them to be your parents they don't know how, or maybe you're a person who doesn't know how to get restored, or maybe you have a hostile husband or a wayward wife, or you may be someone who just feels like the journey of walking with God is too much, you may have lost your home or car or business in a fire, you may have a unsaved spouse, you may feel depressed because your own church don't seem to support you, you may see everyone getting a husband or wife and your saying , what about me God?, and if that's you then God heard your cry.

The Lord God has giving me the tongue of the learned that I may know how to speak a word in season to him or her that maybe weary and the Spirit of God is on me because God anointed me and sent me to preach good news to the poor, and to heal the heartbroken, and to announce freedom to all captives, and to open the prisons to those who maybe bound (Physically, Mentally, Spiritually, and Sexually Bound). 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ashes, Messages of joy instead of news of doom, a Praising Heart instead of a Weary Spirit (**Isaiah 61:1-3**) because God already knew beforehand that **“The Journey is too great for you”**. And being as though it is, you will have to work together with Him, and all that you are required to bring on this journey with God is **‘Faith the size of a mustard seed’** because if you’re going to make it through your journey no matter if it’s personal or ministry related you will need **‘Faith’** to do it! Now it happened as they journeyed on the road, that someone said to Him, “Lord, I will follow you wherever you go.” And Jesus said to him, “Foxes have holes and birds of the air have nests, but the Son of Man has nowhere to lay His head.” Then He said to another, “Follow Me.” But he said, “Lord, let me first go and bury my father.” Jesus said to him, “Let the dead bury their own dead, but you go and preach the kingdom of God.” And another also said, “Lord, I will follow you, but let me first go and bid them farewell that are at my house.” But Jesus said to him, “No one, having put his hand to the plow, and looking back, is fit for the kingdom of God.” (Luke 9:57-62)

When I first started out on this journey with God I would hear certain things being said and to this very day I am often faced with hearing the same things still being

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said, and it shocks me that this comes out of the mouth of believers and unbelievers alike, and it's goes like this 'that worked in the bible for Jesus, but it won't work for me'. If you want '**Real Victory For Real Life**' situations all you have to do is "**Follow Jesus**" but make sure you pay attention to some key words mentioned in (Luke 9), words like "**Journeyed and Looking back**" because this journey is too great for you and it will be even greater if you keep on looking back. Now let me take this time to lay some ground work and build up some people spiritual being through the Word of God so they can be complete, lacking nothing and be prepared for their journey, if you feel little weary, don't feel bad, we all get weary from time to time on this journey with God.

The bible says: **The king of Egypt had a talk with the two Hebrew midwives; one was named Shiphrah and the other Puah. He said, "When you deliver the Hebrew women, look at the sex of the baby. If it's a boy, kill him. (Exodus 1:15-16)**

The bible also says: **Then Herod, when he realized that he had been misled by the wise men, was furiously enraged, and he sent and put to death all the male children. (Matthew 2:16)**

In the Old Testament the enemy orders were to kill the boys, kill the males, kill all the men, and in the New Testament the enemy orders are still the same, kill the boys, kill the males, and kill all the men! If the enemy orders are to kill the men first, and you're a woman reading this, please allow me to build up the men spirit

first. The enemy is aware that if he can keep the men out of their position of leadership he can hinder them in their marriages, which in turn will hinder them in their families, which in turn will hinder them in their churches. As soon I was receiving the words to put in this book I heard someone say this in the spirit **'the devil can't stop God's work'**, and that's true, that's why I used the word **'hindered'** and not **'stop'** now pay attention.

The bible says: **Because it was our will to come to you. [I mean that] I, Paul, again and again [wanted to come], but Satan hindered and impeded us. (1 Thessalonians 2:18)**

One of the greatest tricks I believe the enemy ever pulled over the people of God is to get some of them to think he doesn't exist. On top of that I often hear it preached that Satan knows everything about us and that's a lie from the pit of hell. There is no Scriptural evidence that he can and in fact the indication is that he can't. Take for example the story of Job. God is bragging on how good a servant Job is. Satan says Job will curse God if God removes the hedge.

The bible says: **Then Satan answered the LORD, and said does Job fear God for nothing? Hast not you made a hedge about him, and about his house, and about all that he hath on every side? Thou hast blessed the work of his hands, and his substance is increased in the land. But put forth thine hand now, and touch all that he hath, and he will curse thee to thy face. (Job 1:9-11)** Job stayed true to God which Satan obviously did not know he would do. While we

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learn in Scripture that Satan is powerful and influential, he is not all knowing, or omniscient. Only God has the ability to know all things (Psalms 139).

The bible says: **For all that is in the world—the lust of the flesh, the lust of the eyes, and the pride of life—is not of the Father but is of the world. (1 John 2:16)** All that's in the world is the lust of the flesh, the lust of the eyes and the pride of life, now Satan and his demons are considered to be genius at using those three things, and they never take a day off like we do with the Word of God, But he don't know everything about you.

Jesus said: **I will not talk with you much more, for the prince (evil genius, ruler) of the world is coming. And he has no claim on Me. [He has nothing in common with me; there is nothing in me that belongs to him, and he has no power over me. (John 14:30)** That's what you call Holy Ghost Boldness and we have that same boldness and power over the enemy, God said there is nothing in me that belong to him, we have to become a genius at using God's Word against the enemy as the enemy has become at using those same three things against us.

The bible says: **Eye has not seen, nor ear heard, nor have entered into the heart of man the things which God has prepared for those who love Him. (1 Corinthians 2:9)** Do you think God would tell Satan everything about you, when He didn't even tell you everything about you? He doesn't know everything about you, he didn't have to look into your future to see what

heaven is like, remember he got kicked out of there. We have to stop giving him too much credit and stop tripping and start confession. God has great plans for you and the enemy doesn't even know about them!!! Now grid up the loins of your mind and let's go because the **journey is too great for you!!**

Now back to the enemy having his orders to kill all the men, God wants you to know that as long as you're on this journey with Him. You are the men that the enemy can't kill!!

The bible says: **When they heard this, they were furious and plotted to kill them. Then one in the council stood up, a Pharisee named Gamaliel, a teacher of the law held in respect by all the people, and commanded them to put the apostles outside for a little while. And he said to them: "Men of Israel, take heed to yourselves what you intend to do regarding these men. For some time ago Theudas rose up, claiming to be somebody. A number of men, about four hundred, joined him. He was slain, and all who obeyed him were scattered and came to nothing. After this man, Judas of Galilee rose up in the days of the census, and drew away many people after him. He also perished, and all who obeyed him were dispersed. And now I say to you, keep away from these men and let them alone; for if this plan or this work is of men, it will come to nothing; but if it is of God, you cannot overthrow it—unless you found yourself fighting against God(Acts 5:33-39).**

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Again, if you're a woman and you're reading this and it seems like I'm singling out the men, then you are absolutely correct. If you're a man and you're reading this and it seems like I'm singling you out, then you are absolutely correct as well. But please women bare with me and just keep reading because God said: **I sought for a man among them who would make a wall, and stand in the gap before Me on behalf of the land, that I should not destroy it; but I didn't find one.**(Ezekiel 22:30) God said that He sought for a man not a woman to stand in the gap but he didn't find one (In my sanctified imagination I always said to myself, I bet a woman stepped up, but God wanted a man to stand in the gap). You women have been standing in the gap for our families and on behalf of our land long enough. I can't thank you all personally, but to all the women worldwide, who have stood in the gap on behalf of some men and our land, I salute you and I appreciate you. And I'm aware that I'm not talking about all men, just some, starting with me.

I'll never forget what I saw one Sunday in church, as the service was coming to a close the preacher made this altar call "every leader of the family come to the altar, because families are being attacked and I want to say a prayer for all the leaders of the families", so as I stood there I couldn't help but notice that it was full of women on the altar, now I took in to account that every woman don't have a husband, so they actually are leading their family, then you have the women who have gone through a divorce, so they leading their families to, but you also had some women whose husband was there and they were up there to and their husbands wasn't, then you had

some women who was up there who have a husband that wants to lead but the woman been standing in the gap so long it turned into a tug-a-war between him and her, he want to lead but she's like **'I been doing it this long, I got it'**, then you had some women up there because their man don't want nothing to do with leading their family. This is not to put men down but instead to try to build them up and stir up the gifts that are in them, and to motivate them and to empower them.

The bible says: when I call to remembrance the genuine faith that is in you, which dwelt first in your grandmother Lois and your mother Eunice, and I am persuaded is in you also.(2 Timothy 1:5)

The Apostle Paul said to Timothy your grandmother had genuine faith and your mother as well, so I know it's in you, what he was telling him was that your grandmother stood in the gap and then your mother stood in the gap, but now it's time for you to stand in the gap and that's just what God wants the 'Mighty Men Of God' to do. We are the men that the enemy can't kill and in order for us to have **"Real Victory For Real Life"**, we as the men have to take our rightful positions and as I write that I'm pointing three fingers at 'ME' and only one at 'YOU', but out of all the things that my wife ever said to me Good or Bad, it's one thing that she said that will never leave my spirit and what she said to me was **"baby I just want to be a woman"**, she said that after I felt like she was nagging me and I yelled to her **"What do you want from me?"** and she replied softly **"I just want to be a woman"**, I can't really write the emotions behind

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that which she said, but depending who's reading this right now, I'm sure if you are a woman you can feel the emotions coming off the pages and if you're a man you should be able to feel them to. She was telling me that she was tired of standing in the gap on behalf of me and our family. The enemy can't kill you not because of you, but because the plan, or the work, or the vision, or the journey you have is of God.

The bible says: Then the high priest rose up, and all those who were with him (which is the sect of the Sadducees), and they were filled with indignation, and laid their hands on the apostles and put them in the common prison. But at night an angel of the Lord opened the prison doors and brought them out. (Acts 5:17-19)

Anytime you go from being in bondage in prison and God brings you out He's bringing you out for a reason (remember you can be in bondage physically, spiritually, emotionally, and or sexually). But no matter what your personal situation may be, from the time God opens those prison doors and sets you free **“the journey is too great for you”**. So please don't focus on what you 'can do' or what you 'didn't do' because all you have to do is 'Believe' in what Jesus has already done in front of you. **The bible says: Behold, I send an Angel before you to keep you in the way and to bring you into the place which I have prepared. (Exodus 23:20)** You are the men that the enemy can't kill, and for that matter he doesn't even have enough power to keep you bound! But beware and don't think he will stop plotting to kill you **(See Acts 5). When they heard this, they were furious**

and plotted to kill them (V-33). When the enemy sees and hears that you have been released from his bondage or set free he will still plot to kill you, plot to get you back in bondage.

I remember one Sunday during church service when my wife was the nurse on duty and whenever she is the nurse on duty she either has to sit in the nurse station in the back or the one in the front, either way she can't sit with me, so this Sunday as our Bishop was preaching and a woman who wasn't sitting to far from me asked me did I want to go to dinner and I said no, everybody is going to the hall after service to eat, so as my Bishop continue to preach she leaned over and said; I wasn't talking about us going to eat as couples, I meant me and you, and I said wow, because I thought she was talking about me and my wife and her and her partner. We all know I didn't go because I'm still alive to be writing it in this book 😊 and proof again Satan don't know everything about me because he would've known I wouldn't have went.

Anyway, I remember being in my prayer closet that next morning and I asked God how did He allow that to get to me in church and He said to me, from here on out all your attacks and plots of the enemy has to come to you on your turf to get you, because you don't go to the places you used to go, you don't hang with the people you used to hang with, you don't do what you used to do, so they will all come to you. Unless I send you into the enemies camp to invade his kingdom of darkness with my light!

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Just because the enemy can't kill you don't mean he won't keep plotting against you. But being as though you are the men that the enemy can't kill he has to take heed what he intend to do to you. Remember we are in Acts chapter 5, In **(V-35)** they were told to take heed to themselves in what they intended to do to **'These Men'** (meaning those covered in the blood). In **(V-36)** He goes on to remind them about what they did to this one brother name Theudas who was slain, then in **(V-37)** he went on to remind them about another brother name Judas who also was slain, but in **(V-38)** he says to them, stay away from **'These Men'**, or hands off **'These Men'**, or withdraw from **'These Men'** because if this plan, or this work, or this journey is of man, it will come to nothing, but if it's of God, there is nothing you can do about it, **(V-39)**. You are the men that the enemy can't kill because the journey you're on is of God and this will be **'Real Victory for Real Life'**.

I remember having a vision one day and in this vision I saw Satan demons reporting to him and one by one he asked them, didn't I tell you to attack his marriage? And the demon said, yes sir and I did, then he asked the others, didn't I tell you to attack him with sickness? Yes sir and I did, didn't I tell you to attack his money? Yes sir and I did, didn't I tell you to attack his children? Yes sir and I did. Then Satan said to them, then how is it possible that these men made it thus far? And all the demons said at the same time, we don't know, but it seems like the more we attack **"These Men"** the stronger they get!!!! Hallelujah!!!!!!!

Eye's has not seen nor ear heard what God has in store for you, you are the men that the enemy can't kill and the reason why is because of your father is watching.

When I was a kid it was a bully on my block and as always when we came outside to play he would end up with everyone toys, so this day wasn't any different he took all our toys again and I went to go into the house but my father was sitting on the pouch, and as I walked past him or tried to walk past my father he grabbed me by the arm and said **'son are you scared of him?** And I said yes, my father said listen to me son, I seen people like that a very long time and if you punch him in his mouth one good time he will never mess with you again or yawl will become best friends, so I went over there and asked for my stuff back and he stood in front of me smiling, so I bald up my fist like my father told me and closed my eyes(my father didn't tell me to do that😊) and swung with everything I had and when I heard some noises and they weren't coming from or out of me I opened my eyes and to my surprise I seen the blood coming out of his mouth and him crying, and still to this very day I'll never will forget the words that came out of his mouth and they were, **"You only did that because your father was watching"**, and in saying that, the enemy will try to plot against you to destroy your marriage, or your ministry, or your business, or your family, or your health, or your children, or your mind, or your peace, or your testimony but he won't succeed because **"Your father is watching."** So remember this journey is too great for you but you are the men that the enemy can't kill and no matter what happens and no

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matter how it comes your way always remember that you're Father is watching!!

The bible says: Nevertheless, in the plan of the Lord and from His point of view woman is not apart from and independent of man, nor is man aloof from and independent of woman; For as woman was made from man, even so man is also born of woman; and all whether male or female go forth from God as their Author. (1 Corinthians 11:11-12)

When a woman is pregnant she has the hardest job in the world from God, how do I know? Because when she's carrying that baby God is using her body to create bones. This journey is too great for just men and in order for us to finish this journey we without a doubt will need God, but we cannot afford to neglect **“The Use of a Woman”**.

The bible says: Now Deborah, a prophetess, the wife of Lappidoth, was leading Israel at that time. She held court under the Palm of Deborah between Ramah and Bethel in the hill country of Ephraim, and the Israelites went up to her to have their disputes decided. (Judges 4:4)

Now the bible says that here was a woman who was leading them at this time and it also let us know that she had a husband as well. So to keep the order of things God made sure she had her covering at the same time she was the leader of them not the husband. Just because the husband will always be the head don't mean the woman

can't be called to lead. Her leading doesn't take away the man position as the head. The Church has a few giants that we have to kill and one of those giants is **"The Use of the Woman."** Before she became their leader God had left some of their enemies in their land, this was only so that the generations of the children of Israel might be taught to know war, at least those who had not formerly known it (**Judges 3:1-2**). If you have been fighting something on your journey with God and it seems to appear over and over again, there are few things you need to know 1) God's Grace is sufficient, 2) He may be preparing you for something, 3) He might want to use a woman to win this victory. If you are ever going to get **"Real Victory for Real Life"** on this journey with God you will have to use everything that God put at your disposal. Sometimes we as men and women hinder our journey when we come across a woman in the position of leadership and we don't respond to them the same as when it's a man. Why? I don't know.

The bible says: She sent for Barak son of Abinoam from Kedesh in Naphtali and said to him, "The LORD, the God of Israel, commands you: 'Go, take with you ten thousand men of Naphtali and Zebulun and lead them up to Mount Tabor. I will lead Sisera, the commander of Jabin's army, with his chariots and his troops to the Kishon River and give him into your hands.'" Barak said to her, "If you go with me, I will go; but if you don't go with me, I won't go."(Judges 4:6-8)

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Here was a man, who clearly heard what his leader told him that God said for him to do, and his reply showed he understood what she had said, because he said if she doesn't go with him he won't go, but God told the leader to give him the orders and he never told her to go with him. But I wonder how he would have responded if that was a man in the position of leadership and he gave those same orders?

We may not admit this brother, but some of us do the same thing this man did, we may not be as bold as he was or maybe we are. But this journey is too great for any one of us to try to do it alone and when I say alone I'm not talking about without God, because we know apart from him we can't do anything. But as long as God is God He will always get the Glory and this woman knew that, that's why after he said what he said she responded with:

I will surely go with you; nevertheless there will be no glory for you in the journey you are taking, for the LORD will sell Sisera into the hand of a woman. (Judges 4:9)

She told him she will go with him and that God was going to give them the victory, but the victory was going to come by the hands of a woman (**Judges 4:21**). Never underestimate the **"Use of a Woman"** Eye has not seen, nor ear heard, nor have entered into the heart of man the things which God has prepared for those who love Him. Now that we have empowered the men and women of God for this journey it's **'Time to More Forward!!!!'**

CHAPTER 2 TIME TO MOVE FORWARD

Yet they did not obey or incline their ear, but followed the counsels and the dictates of their evil hearts, and went backward and not forward.

(Jeremiah 7:24)

“Passport to a Spiritual Adventure”

Passport: Any authorization to pass or go somewhere, or permission to proceed!

Spiritual: having a mind or emotions of a high and refined quality

Adventure: A bold, usually risky undertaking action of uncertain outcome.

God normally gives me an idea for a book title first and once I receive that I then wait for the download from Him about what to put in it, it never fails that sometimes I receive nothing and sometimes I receive a lot, I may not ace what He says to do or say in other areas, but I never miss it when He speaks through my personal situations. As I was listening to receive something for this chapter of the book, me and my wife was up one Saturday morning sitting down watching something that was feeding our spirits before we went about our day, then out of nowhere we heard a knock at the door and it turned out to be our landlords, it

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was rent time so we assumed they wanted their rent, but instead they handed us a letter and the letter stated that they were moving back into the house we was currently renting from them on September 26, 2013, it was June 29, 2013(90 days to move).

Now, without getting into any details about all of it, they ran into some hardship and I guess they said to themselves, if we ever run into any hardship we can just make them get out of our house and move back. But they must have forgotten that we serve a great, great, great, great, great God. As me being the Priest, Provider, Protector, and Prophet of my home I was asking God what to do with my wife and my step daughter and her daughter. The next day at church my Bishop started out reading the scriptures and all the lights went out in the sanctuary during service, so me and all the other brothers went to see what happen as my Bishop kept on preaching in the dark, once the lights came back on I went to my seat and my wife said to me, look what the Bishop just read to us and it said: **At break of day, the angels pushed Lot to get going, “Hurry. Get your wife and two daughters out of here before it’s too late and you’re caught in the punishment of the city. Lot was dragging his feet. The men grabbed Lot’s arm, and the arms of his wife and daughters—GOD was so merciful to them!—and dragged them to safety outside the city. When they had them outside, Lot was told, “Now run for your life! Don’t look back! (Genesis 19:15-17)** Now I don’t know why you go to church but I mainly go to hear a Word from God and I heard Him loud and clear after reading that.

So them coming over and telling us we had to move was God telling me and my family that it's **“Time to Move forward.”** One of the things I learned from following Jesus on this journey is that He always went against the traditions of men, in order for us to move forward, we have to stop speaking what we heard and start speaking the Word of God. When we accepted Jesus Christ as our Lord and Savior we were issued **“A Passport to a Spiritual Adventure or a Spiritual Journey”**.

In order for you to be some **‘Earthly Good’** you have to stay **‘Heavenly Minded’** to go on this spiritual journey with God, and I know what you're thinking, I said that wrong, but I'm sorry, I didn't, the church folks picked up **“Don't be so heavenly minded that you become no earthly good”** but tell them to show you that in the bible. I had to correct this foolish saying that the devil sows into people hearts so many times, but it still needs correcting.

The bible says: Then Jesus answered and said to them, “Most assuredly, I say to you, the Son can do nothing of Himself, but what He sees the Father do; for whatever He does, the Son also does in like manner. (John 5:19)

First things first, it says that Jesus focus was on the father, His father wasn't on the earth, so Jesus had to stay **“Heavenly Minded”**, now we all know that Jesus was some **“Earthly Good”**. Second, He is by far the most heavenly minded person to ever walk the planted earth. Third, do you know someone who is more heavenly minded than Him? Do those same people who tell you

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“Don’t be so “Heavenly Minded” ever tell you that to be Earthly Minded means you’re an enemy of the cross? I DOUBT IT.

The bible says: Therefore let us, as many as are mature, have this mind; and if in anything you think otherwise, God will reveal even this to you. Nevertheless, to the degree that we have already attained, let us walk by the same rule, let us be of the same mind. Brethren, join in following my example, and note those who so walk, as you have us for a pattern. For many walk, of whom I have told you often, and now tell you even weeping, that they are the enemies of the cross of Christ: whose end is destruction, whose god is their belly, and whose glory is in their shame—who set their mind on earthly things. (Philippians 3:18-19)

Please resolve it in your heart right now to never use such foolish saying again and to let the Lord correct such thinking that would cause you to believe such deception, it’s time to move forward and if you are to make it on your journey you will have to go against the tradition of men.

The bible says: This wisdom does not descend from above, but is earthly, sensual, and demonic. For where envy and self-seeking exist, confusion and every evil thing are there. But the wisdom that is from above is first pure, then peaceable, gentle, willing to yield, full of mercy and good fruits, without partiality and without hypocrisy. (James 3:15-17)

More than not the statement **“Don’t be so Heavenly Minded”** that you become no **“Earthly Good”** is directed towards the ones who spend a lot of time praying and reading the Word of God and meditating on Heavenly realities and speaking of them! I don’t think we should spiritualize everything. I remember one of my mentors telling me that I have the fire for God, he said, I just have to fine tune it, but he said, I rather work with someone who has the fire and just needs to turn it down some, then to work with someone whom I have to try and get them on fire for God, and in that same vein is those whom we see or say are Heavenly Minded, I rather work with the ones who are heavenly minded then the ones who are earthly minded on this Journey, because this journey is too great to be focused on what we are seeing.

The bible says: Therefore we do not lose heart. Even though our outward man is perishing, yet the inward man is being renewed day by day. For our light affliction, which is but for a moment, is working for us a far more exceeding and eternal weight of glory, while we do not look at the things which are seen, but at the things which are not seen. For the things which are seen are temporary, but the things which are not seen are eternal. (2 Corinthians 4:16-18)

In reality, according to the bible, the more heavenly-minded we are the more earthly good we will be! Why? Because we get to know God more through studying the bible, we see that He desires to be served through our

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service to others and commands us to do so. True heavenly-mindedness leads us to obey God by making disciples and teaching them all that Christ commanded, providing people with physical necessities, comforting others in their affliction, and a ton of other practical examples of doing well on earth. If you aren't heavenly minded you won't learn how to teach people, if you aren't heavenly minded you won't learn that you should comfort others, if you aren't heavenly minded you won't learn about providing for people, if you don't remain heavenly minded you will be no earthly Good, because only God can teach you about things of this magnitude, the earth or the world sure don't function on these guidelines!!

It's **"Time to Move forward"** and staying 'Heavenly Minded' is your **"Passport to a Spiritual Adventure."** Jesus did not base his actions on what people wanted but on where he saw his Father at work (**Mark 1:23-39; Luke 19:1-10; John 5:17, 19-20**). If the Father was working with the multitude, that is where the Son invested himself. If the father was bringing conviction to a lone sinner, that's where Jesus directed his efforts.

The bible says: Roll your works upon the Lord commits and trusts them wholly to Him; He will cause your thoughts to become agreeable to His will, and so shall your plans be established and succeed. (Proverbs 16:3)

Listen to me, if you want to be some "Earthly Good" you have to stay "Heavenly Minded."

The bible says: For those who live according to the flesh set their minds on the things of the flesh, but

those who live according to the Spirit, the things of the Spirit. For to be carnally minded is death, but to be spiritually minded is life and peace. (Romans 8:5-7)

You have a **“Passport to a Spiritual Advantage”** but if you keep trying to get through this journey living off of saying and not off the Word of God, then you’re cheating yourself.

The bible says: Beware lest anyone cheat you through philosophy and empty deceit, according to the tradition of men, according to the basic principles of the world, and not according to Christ. (Colossians 2:8)

The message translation says it this way: **Watch out for people who try to dazzle you with big words and intellectual double-talk. They want to drag you off into endless arguments that never amount to anything. They spread their ideas through the empty traditions of human beings and the empty superstitions of spirit beings. But that’s not the way of Christ.**

Jesus Christ stayed **“Heavenly Minded”** and nobody and I mean nobody was more **“Earthly Good”** than Him. We must seek those things above and mortify the things that are below. If you are like me and you have been following others and have found yourself walking around saying this crap then just ask God to reveal the truth to you and repent and go from there. Wake up church it’s time to move forward!

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I remember me and my wife was going through some marriage issues and at the same time we were working in the ministry, so one day our Bishop and First Lady met with us and they told us that it's best that we sit down from doing ministry work and focus on each other for the next two months, first of all let me take this time to say I thank God I have leaders that care more about the well being of our marriage than being more concerned with us doing work in the ministry, it says a lot about the people we sit under. But nonetheless here I was being told we had to move and then being sat down and then getting a called from my father about a health issue all in about 30 days.

Now if you're truthful, normally all types of things would be flowing through people minds at that time, but I didn't blink or skip a beat and the reason why is, I was and still am "Heavenly Minded".

The bible says: And each one went straight forward; they went wherever the spirit wanted to go, and they did not turn when they went. (Ezekiel 1:12)

If this is the way the Holy Spirit wants to go, then that's the way I'm going, if He wants to go another way, then that's the way I'll go, no matter what it's **"Time to Move Forward"** and I'm going straight forward. Because I know that this journey is too great for me, but I also know that the Lord that I serve can make a crooked road straight, I also know if I stay Heavenly Minded He will walk me right into **"A time of Restoration and Increase"**.

CHAPTER 3 A TIME OF RESTORATION AND INCREASE

Return to the stronghold,
you prisoners of hope.
Even today I declare
that I will restore double to you.
(Zechariah 9:12)

“Victory for a Lifetime”

The bible says: Beloved, I pray that you may prosper in **‘EVERY WAY’** and that your body may keep well, even as I know your soul keeps well and prospers. (3 John 1)

Normally whenever we hear anything about increase we focus on monetary. But God said that we should prosper in **“Every Way”**, and if that’s not the case then it’s no need for you to panic because that why it’s **“A time of Restoration and Increase”** if you need to be restored, God will do it, if you need more money to fulfill your ministry, God will do that also. There will come a time on your journey where you will have to learn how to keep a **“Victory for a Lifetime”** Because the journey is too great for you. As we are on this journey with God we have to keep building, and building, and building and keep building!

The bible says: But the fruit of the Spirit is love, joy, peace, longsuffering, kindness, goodness,

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faithfulness, gentleness, self-control.(Galatians 5:22-23)

If you pay attention to the words in this verse it says: **the fruit of the spirit**, not **fruits** of the spirit, it appears to be singular, but even if it's more than one it still remains **fruit**. Let's say that everything that follows behind **"the fruit of the spirit"** is the ingredients that are in the **"Fruit."** If you're really after a victory for a lifetime on this journey with God then you must build on all those ingredients. Let's start with **"Love"** because that's where it all starts since the beginning of time. Love is always the root we need to grow and you have to decide to stick with it despite what others people do. Cause hate is too great a burden to bear. Faith makes all things possible... love makes all things easy. Jesus said: **a new command I give you: Love one another. As I have loved you, so you must love one another. (John13:34)**

Now to the next ingredient which is **"Joy"** because the joy of the Lord is our Strength. **(Nehemiah 10:8)** Find a place inside of you where there's joy and that joy will burn out the pain of something you may be facing. You have to find joy in everything you choose to do. Every job, relationship, home... it's your responsibility to love it, or change it. I developed my joy when I was on my knees cleaning toilets, I found joy in cleaning those toilets and how I found that joy was cleaning those toilets in such a way that if God needed to use it Himself, He wouldn't have to wait until I cleaned it, so I found joy in doing it every day! I also enjoy writing, sometimes; I think that most writers will tell you about the agony of writing

more than the joy of writing, but writing is what I was meant to do.

Now to the next ingredient which is **“Peace”** An eye for an eye only ends up making the whole world blind. Peace is a journey of a thousand miles and it must be taken one step at a time. Jesus said: **Peace I leave with you; my [own] peace I now give and bequeath to you. Not as the world gives do I give to you. Do not let your hearts be troubled, neither let them be afraid. [Stop allowing yourselves to be agitated and disturbed; and do not permit yourselves to be fearful and intimidated and cowardly and unsettled. (John 14:27 Amplified)**

No person, no place, or nothing has any power over us, for we are the only thinkers in our mind. When we create peace and harmony and balance in our minds, we will find it in our lives. That’s why Jesus said **“stop allowing yourselves to get agitated”** because if we can create that peace by trusting in Him we will put it in our minds and then it will show in our lives.

Now to the next ingredient which is **“longsuffering”** How many men or women has thrown up their hands at a time when a little more effort, a little more longsuffering would have achieved success? Never cut a tree down in the wintertime. Never make a negative decision in the low time. Never make your most important decisions when you are in your worst moods. Wait. Be patient. The storm will pass. The spring will come. I think you can judge from somebody's actions a kind of a stability and sense of purpose perhaps created by strong religious roots. I mean there's certain patience, a certain discipline, I think, that a personal relationship

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with God helps you achieve. The Scriptures contain many stories of people who waited years or even decades before the Lord's promises came to pass. What modern believers can learn from the patience of biblical saints like Abraham, Joseph, David, and Paul is that waiting upon the Lord has eternal rewards. Have patience with all things, But, first of all with yourself.

Now to the next ingredient which is “**kindness**” Beginning today, treat everyone you meet as if they were going to be dead by midnight. Extend to them all the care, kindness and understanding you can muster, and do it with no thought of any reward. Your life will never be the same again. A little thought and a little kindness are often worth more than a great deal of money. Constant kindness can accomplish much. As the sun makes ice melt, kindness causes misunderstanding, mistrust, and hostility to evaporate. It's not our job to play judge and jury, to determine who is worthy of our kindness and who is not. And I have to be honest with you I repenting from doing that. We just need to be kind, unconditionally and without ulterior motive, even - or rather, especially - when we'd prefer not to be. One of my great regrets, and I don't have many, is that I spent too long putting people's status and reputation ahead of their more important qualities. I learned far too late in life that a long list of letters after someone's name is no guarantee of compassion, kindness, humor, all the far more relevant stuff. The end result of kindness is that it draws people to you.

Now to the next ingredient which is “**goodness**” Treat those who are good with goodness, and also treat those who are not good with goodness. This is a sign that

you're a true Christian because the world doesn't think like this! Goodness is about character - integrity, honesty, kindness, generosity, moral courage, and the like. More than anything else, it is about how we treat other people. Each person has inside a basic decency and goodness. If he listens to it and acts on it, he is giving a great deal of what it is the world needs most. It is not complicated but it takes courage. It takes courage for a person to listen to his own goodness and act on it. Today we are afraid of simple words like goodness and mercy and kindness. We don't believe in the good old words because we don't believe in good old values anymore. When you are at the bottom, you find beauty in such little things, and goodness in such little gestures. When I compare any struggle today to ones that I may have had in my childhood, there is nothing that can bring me down, I think goodness is very powerful, but often evil is made more attractive in films. It's a challenge to make goodness appealing. And that's what we are called to do!

Now to the next ingredient which is "**faithfulness**" Your faithfulness makes you trustworthy to God. **The bible says: I thank Christ Jesus our Lord who has enabled me, because He counted me faithful, putting me into the ministry. (1Timothy 1:12)** The Apostle Paul said that God put Him into the ministry because he never messed up, because he never sinned, because he never did anything wrong. NO, NO, NO, NO, NO, NO, he said God did it because he counted him "**Faithful**", your faithfulness makes you trust worthy to God and God will put you where He wants you and it's nothing man or woman can do about it! So you may not ever plant a seed of perfection in the ground while

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you're on this journey with God, but focus on just planting a seed of **“Faithfulness”** and it has to grow and God will do the rest!

Now to the next ingredient which is **“gentleness”** A Christian reveals true humility by showing the gentleness of Christ, by being always ready to help others, by speaking kind words and performing unselfish acts, which elevate and ennoble the most sacred message that has come to our world. You can disarm your enemy by the gentleness of your manner. When you encounter difficulties and contradictions, do not try to break them, but bend them with gentleness and in time they will break.

Now to the next ingredient which is **“self-control”** Punishment may make us obey the orders we are given, but at best it will only teach obedience to authority, not a self-control which enhances our self-respect. Self-control means wanting to be effective. The bible says that Satan try's to use our lack of self control against us. **Come together again so that Satan does not tempt you because of your lack of self-control. (1 Corinthians 7:5)** I defeated some enemies in my life that I been struggling with just by developing my self-control. You will and can do the same. If you want to have a **“Victory for a Lifetime”** then you have to allow the Holy Spirit to develop you in these areas as you're on this journey with God! **The bible says: Jesus increased in wisdom and stature and in favor with God and men. (Luke 2:52)** Once you have increased in all those areas you will have “victory for a lifetime”. **The bible says: In that day you shall not be shamed for any of your deeds In which you transgress against Me; For then I will take away**

from your midst Those who rejoice in your pride,
And you shall no longer be haughty In My holy
mountain. I will leave in your midst a meek and
humble people and they shall trust in the name of
the LORD. The remnant of Israel shall do no
unrighteousness and speak no lies, nor shall a
deceitful tongue be found in their mouth; for they
shall feed their flocks and lie down, and no one shall
make them afraid. Joy in God's Faithfulness. Sing,
O daughter of Zion! Shout, O Israel! Be glad and
rejoice with all your heart, O daughter of Jerusalem!
The LORD has taken away your judgments; He has
cast out your enemy. The King of Israel,
the LORD, is in your midst; you shall see disaster no
more. In that day it shall be said to Jerusalem: "Do
not fear; Zion let not your hands be weak.
The LORD your God in your midst, The Mighty One,
will save; He will rejoice over you with gladness, He
will quiet you with His love, He will rejoice over you
with singing." "I will gather those who sorrow over
the appointed assembly, who are among you, to
whom its reproach is a burden. Behold, at that time I
will deal with all who afflict you; I will save the lame,
And gather those who were driven out; I will appoint
them for praise and fame In every land where they
were put to shame. At that time I will bring you back,
Even at the time I gather you; for I will give you
fame and praise among all the peoples of the earth.
(Zephaniah 3:11-20) God said that He will give us fame
and praise among all the earth. I don't know about you
but I would rather be a God made millionaire over a self
made millionaire! When it's "a time of restoration and

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increase” God is looking to make us known and seen in the world, so that the world can see His glory through His people, and when you start working at developing those ingredient in this chapter as you are on this journey with God, you will find that you may stumble in some areas and can't seem to move forward and it'll become discouraging , but that's okay, you're not in a bad spot that's just the place or area that you want to put **“Under Construction.”**

CHAPTER 4 UNDER CONSTRUCTION

Then the same Sheshbazzar came and laid the foundation of the house of God which is in Jerusalem; but from that time even until now it has been under construction, and it is not finished.
(Ezra 5:16)

“Think Victory”

When I wrote my first book called **“Pushed out the crack house into God’s house”** people seen God using me to speak at different places around the world, some said: He’s not ordained or qualified to be doing that. But they forgot that the bible said: **A man’s gift makes room for him, and brings him before great men. (Proverbs 18:16)** God’s ways are always higher than man’s ways, He already knew that this journey was too great for me, just like He knows it’s too great for you, He also knew that I would run into this situation, just like He knew you would run into the situation that’s before you today. In my personal situation that’s why He made me a **“Published Author”** before anything else. **The bible says: Not that we are fit (qualified and sufficient in ability) of ourselves to form personal judgments or to claim or count anything as coming from us, but our power and ability and sufficiency are from God. [It is He] Who has qualified us [making us to be fit and**

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worthy and sufficient] as ministers. (2 Corinthians 3:5-6 Amplified) People assumed that God just pushed me out the crack house straight into his house to do what He called me to do. But to those who are unaware please allow me to inform you of a few things so you won't hinder what God has for you to do for the body of Christ. When a person who is coming off of drugs or any kind of bondage or coming from their old life to a new one, they first are pushed out the crack house or out of their old life, then they are put into a place called **"DETOX"** and while they are at that place God has them **"Under Construction."** While He has us under construction God's aim is to transform our minds to get us to **"Think Victory."**

The bible says: But none of these things move me; nor do I count my life dear to myself, so that I may finish my race with joy, and the ministry which I received from the Lord Jesus.(Acts 20:24) You have to realize that you have your own personal race, personal assignment, personal process, and a ministry. The apostle Paul said, so that I may finish **"My Race"** and **"The Ministry"** Which I received from God. When you are under construction you will have to learn all about separating the two if you are ever going to think victory. Don't allow people to trick you into thinking you are outside the will of God if your focus is on doing what God called you to do.

The bible says: Roll your works upon the Lord [commit and trust them wholly to Him; He will cause your thoughts to become agreeable to His will,

**and] so shall your plans be established and succeed.
(Proverbs 16:3 Amplified)**

As long as you commit your work, business, plans, dream, desires to Him, it says that He will cause your thoughts to be agreeable to **“His Will.”**

The bible also says: And the Lord your God will make you abundantly prosperous in every work of your hand.... And the Lord will again delight in prospering you. (Deuteronomy 30:9) While we are under construction and God is transforming our minds at the same time, He’s causes our plans to come agreeable to His will, which in turn will give us what we will need for this journey, and God wants us to share what He has done for us and not hold it back, don’t hold back what He done for you because you fear haters, tell them what God did for you.

The bible says: Jesus refused to permit him, but said to him, Go home to your own [family and relatives and friends] and bring back word to them of how much the Lord has done for you.(Mark 5:19).

Tell someone what God has done in your life. But here is something that you must plant in your spirit and I don’t care how much of a flunky people think you are, **Serve your man or woman of God. The bible says: If you have not been faithful in what is another man’s, who will give you what is your own? (Luke 16:12)** I can’t explain how some of the things God spoke to me has started to come to past, I’ve noticed that the more that I served my man or woman of God, the more I

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helped them with what they are called to do, my doors opened.

The bible says: I found the place wide open: God had opened the door; all I had to do was walk through it. (2 Corinthians 2:12) As you enter those doors after being under construction, it's time for your **“New Beginnings!**

CHAPTER 5 NEW BEGINNINGS

**Therefore if any person is in grafted in Christ (the Messiah) he is a new creation (a new creature altogether); the old previous moral and spiritual condition has passed away. Behold the fresh *and* new has come!
(2 Corinthians 5:17)**

“The Thrill of Victory”

When we read the bible, we should all love it when God asks us a question, Why? Because He doesn't ask for Himself, He already knows the answer, He asks us because He wants us to understand and get it! Get what? Great question and I'm glad you asked! He wants us to get the fact that we are headed towards **“New Beginnings.”** For some of us, we are standing in our new beginnings and we don't even realize it. While you're on this journey with God He will often ask you questions and being as though He is **‘All-Knowing’** He must be asking the question to bring us into new beginnings, because He knows that the journey is too great for you!

He starts off with questions like: **Adam where are you? (Genesis 3:9)** Observe the startling question, Adam, where are you? Those who by sin go astray from God should seriously consider where they are; they are afar off from all good, in the midst of their enemies, in bondage to Satan, and in the high road to utter ruin. This

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lost sheep had wandered without end, if the good Shepherd had not sought after him, and told him, that where he was straying he could not be either happy or pleasing to God. God knows where you are on this journey and if you are not where you should be He will ask you the same question.

Another question you may hear is: **What is that in your hand? (Exodus 4:2)** God asked Moses what he had in his hand because Moses was telling him that the people wouldn't believe he was called by God. So Moses said, I have a rod in my hand, God told him to cast it to the ground and it turned into a serpent, God said grab it by the tail, and it turned back into the rod, Moses not knowing that he held something in his hand that could perform the miracle the whole time, just like I said before, some of us are standing right in our new beginnings and don't even realize that we are holding the blessings right in our hands. Stop looking for the miracle to come, you have the miracle in your hands and it's the Word of God! So pray and fast and do whatever you have to on this journey, but if you ever feel like God is not answering you maybe He's asking you, what is that in your hand?

Another question you may hear is: **Whom shall I send? (Isaiah 6:8)** It's great comfort to those whom God sends, because they go for God, and may therefore speak in his name, assured that he will bear them out. This is the thrill of victory when God ask you whom shall I send? You should respond like the Prophet Isaiah and say **"send me"**, because if He's asking that question then everything else is already taking care of. A lot of believers say **"I'm not worthy"** like John in **(Luke 3:16)**, but what

God is trying to show us is, after we accepted His son, we all are worthy of receiving what we are going to receive in our **“New Beginnings.”** He asked whom shall I send to see if you believed that you are worthy of doing what He called you to do, God don’t call the qualified he qualify the called, So He want to see if you believe that you were made righteous(**Romans 5:17-19**). Never allow the things you still struggle with to determine your worth in God’s eyes, remember Abraham was counted as righteous not because he didn’t sin, but because he believed God (**Galatians 3:6**). Now whom shall I send?

Another question you may hear is: **Will a man rob God?** Normally when we hear this in our church circles we all think about (**Malachi 3:8**), but when God is asking us this question as we are on this journey with Him, He’s talking about us using our God giving gifts to serve the world, all good and perfect gifts is from above and comes down from the father of lights (**James 1:17**). No matter what your gifts and talents are, they are to be used for the kingdom of God and if we are using them any other way, then we are robbing God, so just repent and turn back to do his will and if you don’t remember what His will is, just ask Him to teach you to do His will all over again (**Psalms 143:10**), when God sees us operation in our gifts, it’s a compliment to Him, let me say that again, when God sees us operating in our gifts, it’s a compliment to God.

Another question you may hear is: **What do you want me to do for you?** (**Mark 10:51**). Bartimeus had heard of Jesus and his miracles, and learning that he was passing by, hoped to recover his eyesight. In coming to Christ for help and healing, we should look to him as the promised

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Messiah. If we come to him we shall have what we came for. Isn't that such a simple question? Wouldn't we better serve others if we asked them questions, listened to their answers, honored their request, and then affirmed their commitment and faith? Unfortunately we often think we know best how to help people so we do what we think best rather than asking them what they need. While we can't honor every wish and sometimes people's needs seem self-evident and straightforward, asking them for input gives them the opportunity to share what's on their hearts, and to express their needs while at the same time it affirms their dignity at a time when they may feel like they have lost every shred of dignity.

Another question you may hear is: **Can these bones live? (Ezekiel 37:3)** The question “can these bones live?” seems to suggest, from a human point of view, that the situation was hopeless and beyond recovery. And that’s how you might be feeling about something in your life right now. What do the bones represent for you? Are you feeling far from God? Is your marriage failing? Can you find a God-fearing partner? Are you finding it impossible to take care of your family? Are you failing at school? The question comes to you, **“can these bones live?”**, “can these situations be rectified?” God is asking you this tough question because He wants to test your faith in Him. Do you merely know Him or have you given Him full control of your life. When we fail to recognize God as the answer to our cares and seek to take them on ourselves we will eventually head up the way of the bones. When we cannot see success, we become despondent because **“a crushed spirit dries up the bones.” (Proverbs 17:22)** Your situation has come up

before the Lord and He wants to begin the process of spiritual restoration. He says, "I will lay sinews upon you, and will bring flesh upon you, and cover you with skin, and put breath into you and you shall live; and ye shall know that I am the Lord." (Ezekiel 37:6).

God has asked singular question to many, **He asked Abraham, Is there anything too hard for the Lord (Genesis 18:14), He asked Elijah, What are you doing here? (1 King 19:13), he even asked a no name man a question, the bible says: He asked a certain man, do you want to be made well? (John 5:6), He asked Peter, three times, do you love me? (John 21:15, 16, 17)** While you're walking in your new beginning and on your journey with God, He will often ask you questions as well, and hopefully you know that he's not asking because he doesn't know the answers to the questions, he's asking because he wants you to get some understanding about your journey, so that you can have the thrill of victory, from this point forward it's very, very, very important that you always understand that if it seems impossible to you, **"With God Nothing Shall Be Impossible."**

Digging Deeper into God's Word

This particular friend signed up to box and trained a couple days and wanted a boxing match right away, so he gets his first boxing match and of course all of us was there to

watch, the bell rings and round one is off, my friend goes out there and his opponent started beating his butt, pow, pow, pow ding, ding, ding, round one is over, thank God my friend probably said☺, we were kids, let me remind you, so we weren't encouraging him we were laughing at him. So round two starts and the same thing happen, that boy my friend was boxing was good, because he was beating my friend up in that ring, ding, ding, ding round two is over, so my friend comes to the corner and he tell the trainers to cut the tape, the trainers says to him, it's not over yet you still have one more round to go and my friend yells again **“CUT THE TAPE”**, so the trainers ask him **Why? When my wife oldest daughter was getting married on 6/15/2013 I watched as my wife actually try to do everything by herself, and if you knew my wife you would know that she would actually do whatever she can to help you out. We got up early that morning and went to set up the outside of the place where the wedding was going to be held, and after that, we went inside where the reception was going to be, to start setting that up. We started out at about 9 or 10 in the morning and as she started to put things together and I got my orders from her to put this here, and lift this, and slide this over here, and let that hang and move this here(The already married men know what I mean , you soon to be married men will find out☺) and being as though I don't think God bless me with the grace or the anointing to do all this decorating stuff, I was ready to go and got bored quick, when I saw that it wasn't any heavy lifting left, I felt It wasn't any need for me to do too much helping after that, but not too long after that her two friends and one of their daughters came on the scene, so I went next door to the store to get me something to

eat, something I know God gave me the grace to do☺ and in turn it also gave me a chance to get out the way of the women who God anointed to do this stuff☺.

So I noticed as the time kept on moving, it's now going on 1pm and my wife is trying to make sure everything is just how her daughter wants it to be on the inside which isn't at all bad, but her daughter also wants her mom to meet her at her hotel at 3pm to get in the limousine with everyone, so here we are in Vineland NJ at 1pm and we have to ride 30 minutes to Bridgeton NJ to get my wife home to get dressed, and then another 30 minutes back to Vineland and we are expected to be there by 3pm, if we leave now I'm telling my wife we can pull it off, I put the hour she needs to get dress in with the traveling time, **see the bible says: Adam knew eve his wife (Genesis 4:1).**

So my wife friends are telling her, **“Lernell what you need done inside and outside we will go to the store and bring it back before you guys come”** go ahead Lernell we got it, she starts coming towards me so I think we leaving, perfect, she will make it, I'm saying to myself. But as we go outside my wife say; no baby, I still have to go back outside and do some stuff, wow! As we start doing this it's now 1:30pm and we are still doing whatever was needed outside, and again I'm done and ready to go but because the chairs outside wasn't right, my wife wanted them fixed, she wants me to come in the front to see that the chairs aren't straight and I don't care, not that I don't care that everything won't be right for the wedding, I already know that her two friends only need her to tell them how she wants it done and they will do it as if it was their own daughter's wedding and I knew that,

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so I tell my wife it's 1:45pm we have to go and you have to let your friends finish whatever else you need done, finally she's willing to leave and as we get into her truck I looked at my wife and said nothing, because I was actually getting things downloaded into my spirit from God about what to put in this book and as I looked at my wife again I thought to myself, **“no matter how much she is willing to do and how much she has the heart and compassion and love to do it for others”, the journey or the mission, or the ministry, or the task, or the assignment, or the vision that she had was too great for just her,** just like what God called you to do or what your facing today is too great for you!

What my wife had on her plate was too great for her, but only because she wasn't willing to take and use the help that was sent to her and God showed me that I did the same thing leading up to writing this book, I had something's that were too great for me and I had help, my helper, my comforter, the Holy Spirit(**John 14:15-18**), but I never used my help, and all the questions you may be having about how to handle this, and how you're going to overcome that, and why did God call you to lead them, have led you to a crisis of belief, and the truth of the matter is, that which is before you is too great for you, so you have to work with Him(God), The bible says: **we then as workers together with Him. (2 Corinthians 6:1)**

Being as though the journey(assignment) my wife was on or had was too great for her she started to lose her joy for doing what she enjoys doing and me not doing whatever she needed me to do didn't help that situation at all (**Pray for me, don't talk about me, I'm a work in**

progress). Anyway, how do I know she was losing her Joy? Because I seen that expression before and I felt that feeling before in my own life, that's the same thing that happen to me on my journey with God when I went back to being in bondage to that **"Spiritual Crack Cocaine."** I had loss the joy of the journey; I had loss the joy of running with the vision. I remember a pastor friend of mines told me that I had loss my joy because I wasn't rooted and grounded in the Word of God, I'm a student of the Word of God and I pride myself in that **(pride in the good sense of the word)**, now back to my friend, I take whatever a believer gives me with all readiness, from the ones who have title's to the ones that don't, because if God can use a bird to feed a man and have a donkey talk to another one, than anyone can have a good word from God, anyway, after I receive information from anyone, I have a great habit of lining it up with the Word of God, and I learned to do what those Christians did in the Book of Acts, The bible says: **These were more fair-minded than those in Thessalonica, in that they received the word with all readiness, and searched the Scriptures daily to find out whether these things were so.(Acts 17:11)**

It says they searched the scriptures daily to find out if what they was hearing was true or not **(Note to the reader: you are responsible to do that for yourself, so you can always know if what someone is saying to you is true or not, if it doesn't line up with the Word of God don't receive it)**. Now where was I? Anyway, after going to God about what my friend said about this joy thing and listening to the Holy Spirit, He led me to **(Matthew 4)** where Jesus is being tempted in the

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wilderness by the devil and in that whole ordeal Jesus stood on the Word of God no matter what that devil throw His way, He was rooted and grounded in the Word of God without a doubt, He said “It is written” three times, but in (v.11) it says that angels came and ministered to Him, to take care of His needs, or to refresh Him(Depending on what translation you read), so I learned that I didn’t lose my joy because I wasn’t rooted and grounded in the Word of God, it was because after standing on the Word against the enemy over and over and over again, I never allowed God angels to come minister to me, or refresh me, or take care of my needs.

Some may say it was the sin that made me lose my joy, and to them I say, no it wasn’t, I lost my joy before the sin came, the sin came from me trying to replace that joy with something and that something wasn’t God, it was that **“Spiritual Crack Cocaine.”** David asked God: **To restore to him the joy. (Psalm 51:12)** David knew that in order to finish the journey or to finishing running with the vision he would need the joy back, because the opposite of joy is sorrow or pain. The bible says: **Most assuredly, I say to you that you will weep and mourn, but the world will rejoice; and you will be sorrowful, but your sorrow will be turned into joy. A woman, when she is in labor, has sorrow because her hour has come; but as soon as she has given birth to the child, she no longer remembers the anguish(pain or sorrow), because of the joy. (John 16:20-21 Amplified)**

“The Journey is too Great for You.” and anytime you start to lose ‘**The Joy of the Journey**’ or ‘**The Joy of Running with the Vision**’, the next step in that downward slide is Satan will start working on your mind,

and what he wants to do is, try to get you to start thinking about quitting the journey your on with God, or get you to start thinking about wanting to die instead of finishing the journey, the verse says that a woman no longer remembers her anguish or her pain or her sorrow because of the joy, if we forget the joy of what we are called to do we will remember all the pain, that's why one of the fruit of the spirit is 'Joy' and I'm not sure why, but it says a lot to me that after love it's followed by "Joy", it's second(Galatians 5:22).

The bible says: Therefore we also, since we are surrounded by so great a cloud of witnesses, let us lay aside every weight, and the sin which so easily ensnares us, and let us run with endurance the race that is set before us, looking unto Jesus, the author and finisher of our faith, who for the joy that was set before Him endured the cross, despising the shame, and has sat down at the right hand of the throne of God.(Hebrews 12:1-2)

No matter what came Jesus way as He walked through His journey here on earth as a man, He would never focus on what was happening to Him, not on the pain he suffered, not on the sorrow, but He always focused on the Joy that was set before Him, and that's the way we have to be, we have to pay attention to **"The Joy of the Journey."**

The bible says: What a God! His road stretches straight and smooth. Every GOD-direction is road-tested. Everyone who runs toward him makes it. (2 Samuel 22:31)

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What God is telling us is, every journey I send you on I have tested it out, every vision I gave you will come to past, every ministry I birth with you will succeed, every business you start will be successful, every child I promise will come back to me will, every sickness in your body that you have you are healed from, every direction I give you I have tested it out myself, before I called you to do it I tested it out to make sure that you would make it, please don't lose **"The Joy of the Journey"** because God knows that the journey is too great for you, but he promised that everyone that runs towards Him will make it. The question you have ask yourself is, am I on my journey to please God or Man? As long as you're on the journey to please God don't allow anything to move you. The Apostle Paul called for the elders of the church and spoke to them from morning time to midnight about the journey he was about to go on and about what they were going to face on their journey as well.

The bible says: From Miletus he sent to Ephesus and called for the elders of the church. And when they had come to him, he said to them: "You know, from the first day that I came to Asia, in what manner I always lived among you, serving the Lord with all humility, with many tears and trials which happened to me by the plotting of the Jews; how I kept back nothing that was helpful, but proclaimed it to you, and taught you publicly and from house to house, testifying to Jews, and also to Greeks, repentance toward God and faith toward our Lord Jesus Christ. And see, now I go bound in the spirit to Jerusalem, not knowing the things that will

happen to me there, except that the Holy Spirit testifies in every city, saying that chains and tribulations await me. But none of these things move me; nor do I count my life dear to myself, so that I may finish my race (my process, my mission, my assignment, my marriage, my vision, my journey) with joy, and the ministry which I received from the Lord Jesus, to testify to the gospel of the grace of God. (Acts 20:17-24)

Its nine different things we can learn from the Great Apostle Paul in regards to our journey.

- 1) God will always call you or tell you about this Journey the same way the Apostle Paul called for the elders to tell them about their Journey **(V-17)!**
- 2) You still must come to God about this Journey so you can hear what He has to say, the same way they came to Apostle Paul to hear what he had to say to them **(V-18a)!**
- 3) Always live the same way while on this Journey **(V-18b)** Let us hold fast the confession of our hope without wavering **(Hebrews 10:23)!**
- 4) Always serve the Lord with all humility, through your tears, through your temptations, and through the plots of others while you on this Journey **(V-19)!**

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- 5) Always try to teach someone the lesson you learned from your failures while on this Journey **(V-20)**, And the Lord said, “Simon, Simon! Indeed, Satan has asked for you, that he may sift you as wheat. But I have prayed for you; that your faith should not fail; and when you have returned to me, strengthen your brethren.”**(Luke 22:31-32)!**

- 6) Always testify to everyone while you’re on this Journey, not just to the one’s you think will receive the gospel **(V-21)!**

- 7) Realize for your safety God won’t reveal some things to you on this Journey **(V-22)!** It is not for you to know times or seasons which the Father has put in His own authority **(Acts 1:7)!**

- 8) Don’t let this shock you, but chains and tribulation awaits you on this Journey **(V-23)!** These things I have spoken to you, that in me you may have peace. In the world you will have tribulation; but be of good cheer, I have overcome the world.”**(John 16:33)**

- 9) Lastly “Don’t allow anything to move you off this Journey **(V-24)!!!!**

You have to finish your race, your process, your mission, your assignment, your ministry, your marriage, your vision and your Journey with joy! Remember the joy of the Lord is your strength. Make sure you don't become so full of yourself and your things that you forget GOD, your God, the God who delivered you from bondage; the God who led you through that huge and fearsome Journey, with fiery snakes and scorpions; the God who gave you water gushing from hard rock; the God who gave you manna to eat in the wilderness, something your ancestors had never heard of, in order to give you a taste of the hard life, to test you so that you would be prepared to live well in the days ahead of you. If you start thinking to yourselves, "I did all this, all by myself. I'm rich. It's all mine!"—well, think again. Remember that GOD, your God, gave you the strength to produce all this wealth! **(Deuteronomy 8:11-18).**

In closing the bible says: But he himself went a day's journey into the wilderness, and came and sat down under a broom tree. And he prayed that he might die, and said, "It is enough! Now, LORD, take my life, for I am no better than my father's!" Then as he lay and slept under a broom tree, suddenly an angel touched him, and said to him, "Arise and eat." Then he looked, and there by his head was a cake baked on coals, and a jar of water. So he ate and drank, and lay down again. And the angel of the LORD came back the second time, and touched him, and said, "Arise and eat, because **'The Journey is too Great for you'** (1 King 19:4-7)!"






